

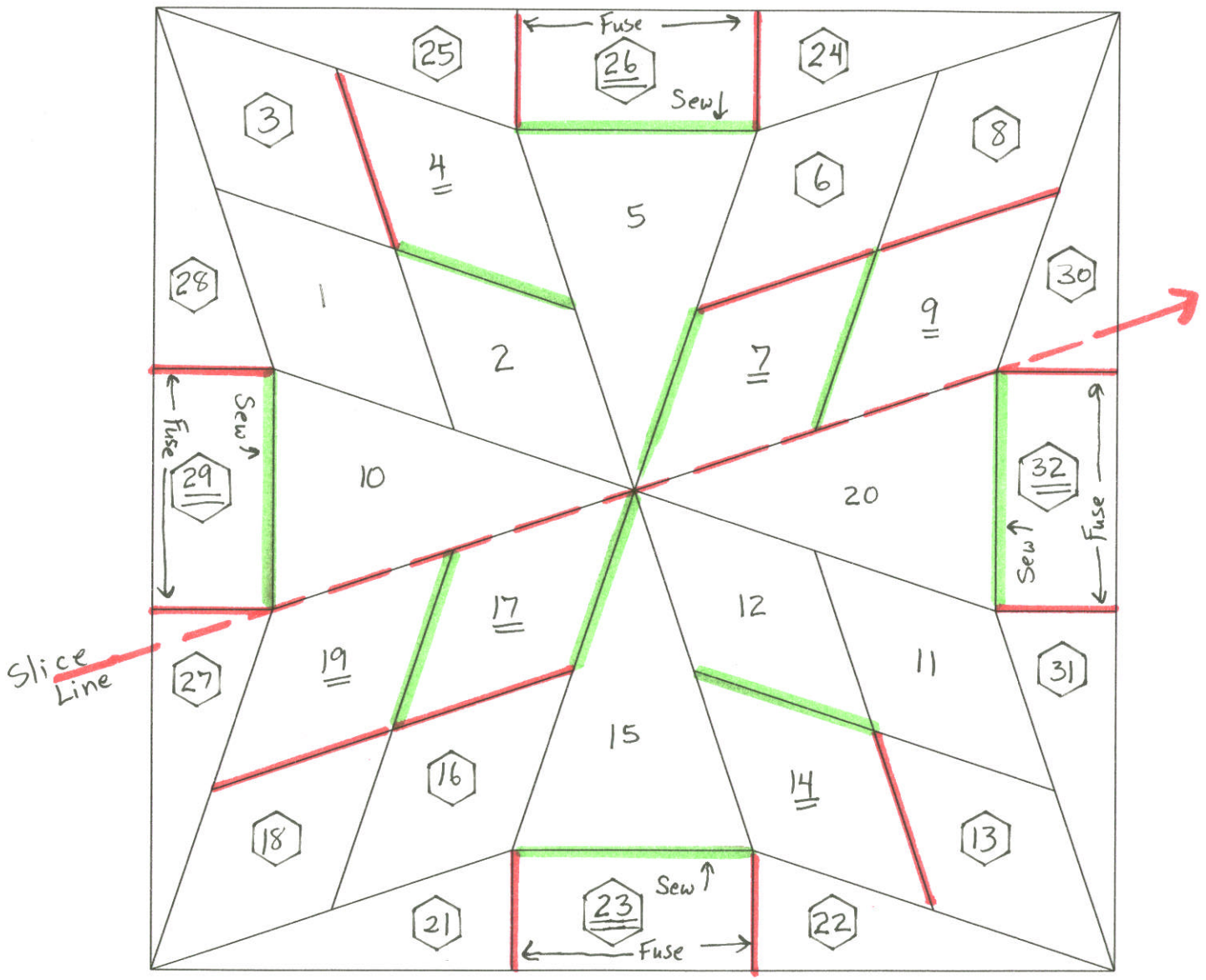
Errata for
Bonus Pattern! Flip-Flop Paper Piecing

On the cover of [Flip-Flop Paper Piecing](#) (bottom right above Mary Kay Mouton's name), a block is pictured that is not included in the book. Mary Kay would like everyone to have the pattern for that block as a bonus. Here is what she says: "If this block had been included in the book, it would have been placed in the final instructional chapter as a 'Combo,' a block constructed using techniques from more than one chapter. The chapters used would be *Chapter 4: When Seams Collide* and *Chapter 7: Two Become One*.

The use of multiple techniques in one block plus the large number of pieces in this block make it a challenge to construct, but it definitely can be pieced with the techniques included in *Flip-Flop Paper Piecing*."

Attached is the Bonus Combo Pattern.



1. Cut along the Slice Line
2. Sew pieces 1 through 20
3. Sew the 2 sections together, taping foundation at ends.
4. Sew pieces 21-32
