
Errata for Sylvia's Bridal Sampler from Elm Creek Quilts #10686

First through Fourth Printings

Page 20, Blazing Star block:

Step 2, last sentence, should read: Cut 4 strips 1 1/8" wide at a 45° angle. Cut 4 more 1 1/8"-wide strips at the opposite 45° angle, as shown.



Page 21, Boy's Nonsense block:

The photo of the block is correct. The illustration erroneously shows triangles making up the rectangles. To correctly piece the block with the foundation patterns on page 89, for pattern A use a rectangle to cover sections 1, 2, and 3, then add the remaining 3 triangles. Likewise, for pattern B, use a rectangle to cover sections 6, 7, and 8, as well as sections 9, 10, and 11.

Page 25, Chinese Coin block:

Step 3 should read: Cut 1 background C square 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" AND cut 4 background E rectangles 1 3/4" x 1 5/8". (*Note: Piece E is a new piece - PDF is attached showing its placement.* This illustration replaces the one at the bottom right of the page.)

Page 52, New Mexico block:

In Step 1, the last sentence should read: Crosscut into 8 strips 15/16" wide.

In Step 2, the last sentence should read: From the remaining strip set, crosscut 4 strips 15/16" wide.

Night & Noon block:

The foundation patterns for this block are on page 111.

Page 65, Sawtooth Star block:

Step 3 should read: Cut 1 A square 2 5/8''' x 2 5/8'' from green fabric.
