On a Mac, you can use the native program, Preview, to open and convert the eps files to pdf files so they can be printed.

- Open the file in Adobe Reader (free program available from adobe.com) and choose File > Print. (If the Print dialog box contains only two pop-up menus and some buttons across the bottom, click the disclosure triangle next to the Printer pop-up menu.)
- 2. Page Scaling should be set to "None."
- 3. Click on the Print button at the bottom of the dialog box.
