

# Sunset Quilt

## Class Description



Use one paper piecing foundation as the center portion of the quilt and also as the border design to make this contemporary style quilt shown on page 90. Even someone new to paper piecing will be comfortable making this quilt and an experienced paper piecer will enjoy using this new approach of joining rectangular foundations in different ways. Learn to paper piece and join blocks accurately. You will easily accomplish several blocks in class and be on your way to completing your quilt at home. You will love the accuracy paper piecing offers and the creative options presented for these

rectangular foundations.

## Class Length

6 hours to permit students to feel comfortable making and joining several blocks

## Class Supply List

Required text: *Carol Doak's Creative Combinations* by Carol Doak

**Carol Doak's Legal Size Foundation Paper**-Print 34 Double-Duty Unit 7 foundations

Sewing machine, thread, flat-headed pins, rotary cutter, mat, 6" x 14" rotary ruler, 12"

Add-A-Quarter ruler, large postcard or cardstock at least 12" long

Fabrics: (Feel free to stop by the shop to choose your fabrics with our assistance.)

Purple: 1 3/4 yards for inner border and blocks

Medium blue: 1 3/4 yards for binding, corner squares, and blocks

Light blue: 1 3/4 yards for blocks

Orange: 3/4 yard for blocks

Light pink: 1 yard for blocks

Medium pink: 1 yard for blocks

Teal: 1 yard for blocks

## Pre-class Preparation

Cut and label the following pieces and bring them to class.

Cut the pieces across the width of the fabric from selvage to selvage

Cutting For Setting Pieces, Inner Border, and Binding:

Fabric	Number to Cut	Size to Cut	Location
Purple	4	6 1/2" x 36 1/2"	Inner border

Medium blue	8	6 1/2" x 6 1/2"	Corner Squares
	7	2 1/4" x 42"	Binding

### Cutting For Blocks:

Fabric	Number to Cut	Size to Cut	Location Number
Purple	34	2 1/4" x 12 3/4"	9
Medium blue	34	2 1/4" x 12 3/4"	4
Orange	34	3 3/4" x 4 3/4"	1
Light Blue	68	3" x 4"	2, 3
	68	2 1/4" x 7 1/4"	7, 8
Light pink	34	3" x 8 1/2"	5
Medium pink	34	3" x 8 1/2"	6
Teal	68	2 1/4" x 7 1/4"	10, 11

Optional item: Curved pointed snips.

### **Classroom Preparation**

Each student needs a sewing machine area and cutting area next to their machine; set up common pressing stations.

### **Class Agenda**

Follow the instructions beginning on page 91 to construct the blocks and quilt.

1. Trim the foundations 1/4" from dotted line
2. Assemble paper piece 4 blocks. (Make just 4 blocks so students will have an understanding of assembly line paper piecing and joining blocks in both ways.)
3. Show how to join blocks to create 12" blocks in center of quilt.
4. Show how to join blocks to create borders.
5. Continue to make remaining blocks and finish blocks at home if needed.
6. Discuss how to construct center of quilt at home.
7. Discuss how to construct 4 borders at home.
8. Discuss how to assemble quilt at home.
