BEADED STITCH SAMPLER

From Beading Artistry for Quilts by Thom Atkins

Class Description

Students will learn basic stitches for bead embroidery on a quilt and leave class with a sampler of stitches. They'll enjoy learning how to make beads do what they want them to do.

Skill level: Beginning to advanced beaders with hand sewing skills

Class Length

Minimum 6 hours for Beads I—Basic Bead Embroidery

Option: Extend the class to multiple shorter sessions over a period of several weeks and add Beads II—Bezels and Borders
