

Tumble Baby Quilt

Beginner's Quilting Class

From *Growing Up Modern* by **Allison Harris**

Class Description

Learn to make a quilt from start to finish! If you've never made a quilt before this class is the perfect place to start. Learn simple cutting, piecing, and finishing techniques and take home a Tumble quilt (page xx) that any new Mom will love!

Class Length

Series of 3 - 1 1/2 hour classes. 1 class to teach cutting and piecing. 1 class to finish piecing, pressing, basting, and beginning quilting. 1 class to finish the quilting and bind. Students can take home the quilt in between classes and work on them. If students are comfortable with the basics, 2 class sessions is probably enough.

Class Supply List

- Required text: *Growing Up Modern*
- 6 fat quarters of print fabrics
- 1/2 yard neutral fabric
- 1 1/2 yards backing fabric
- 1/2 yard binding fabric
- batting 38" x 47"

Classroom Preparation

Each student needs a sewing machine; set up common cutting and pressing stations.

Class Agenda

1. Starting with the instructions on page XX, cut the fabrics accordingly.
2. Piece the quilt top.
3. Press and baste the quilt top with the batting, and backing. Refer to chapter 2 on page XX for instructions and photos for finish your quilts.
4. Quilt the layers together.
5. Bind the quilt.
