- 25/8 yards quilting cotton
- 36" x 42" piece of batting
- 6" x 8" scraps of fabric for flaps
- 2 yards each of 4 trims
- 12 felt or fabric scraps measuring 4" x 4"
- 12" x 12" green felt for leaves
- 4 buttons, 1" diameter
- thread

Class Agenda:

- Start by selecting fabrics and trims for the project.
 Cut all of the flaps and mat fabric.
- 3. Finish one mat in class; students can continue to work on and maybe finish all of the mats.
- 4. Sewing the binding can be done at home.
