- 1 yard for shorts and pocket (1 ¼ yards for size 12)
- 1/2 yard 3/4"-wide buttonhole elastic
- 1 ¼ yards ½"-wide crocheted lace
- ³⁄₄" button for waistband
- Two 1/2" buttons for buttonhole elastic
- 7" zipper
- Pattern tracing medium
- Chalk/marking pen
- Ruler
- Measuring tape
- Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat
- Sewing machine
- Thread

Class Agenda:

- 1. Trace pattern piece.
- 2. Cut pieces from fabric, using a rotary cutter for basic rectangles.
- 3. Sew, demonstrating attaching trims, patch pockets, and trouser zippers.
