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## **4-Grid, page 9**

Dutchman's Puzzle is block 32, not 33.

## **8-Grid, page 10**

Dutch Rose is block 33, not 32.

## **Precut Friendly Index, page 11 (first printing only)**

Under the Charm Squares heading, the Flock block is number 34. The blocks that use fat quarters begin with Arizona, Starshine uses charm squares.

## **Basket H, page 27 (first printing only)**

The second and fourth illustrations should have shaded triangles at the basket base, like the third illustration.

## **Birds in the Air, page 28**

In the Precut Friendly box, the block size should be 8".

## **Cat's Cradle, page 33 (first printing only)**

The block number is 21, not 22.

## **Fox and Geese, page 49**

The first block size in the chart should be 4".

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**Monkey Wrench, page 69 (third printing only)**

The first block size in the chart should be 4".

**Ohio Star, page 77**

The third line under Yardage for Lap Quilt should be 3 x 3 diagonal setting with 4 alternate blocks = 9 pieced blocks.

**Susannah, page 108 (first printing only)**

The first illustration, and the smaller one in the upper right corner are incorrect. The block is 2-grid.

**Tea Leaf, page 110 (first printing only)**

Block 98 is Tea Leaf, not Arizona

**Yardage for Squares, page 125**

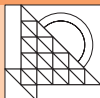
For cut size 2", the number of squares from 3/4 yard should be 273, and the number from 1 yard should be 378.

**Side and Corner Triangles for Diagonal Settings, page 126 (third printing only)**

The first finished block size should be 3".

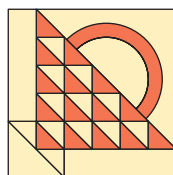
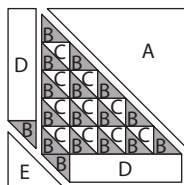
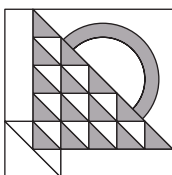
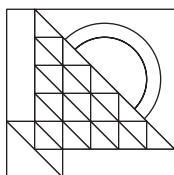

### YARDAGE FOR TABLE TOPPER OR WALLHANGING

38<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" × 38<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"

9" block

3 × 3 diagonal setting  
= 9 blocks

**A, C, D, E, corner triangles:**

1<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yards

**B:** 1/2 yard, or 9 jelly roll strips

**Handles:** 1/4 yard

### CUTTING

*Note: Refer to Side and Corner Triangles for Diagonal Settings (page 126).*

**A:** Cut 2 strips 8<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut into 5 squares 8<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 8<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

**C:** Cut 3 strips 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut into 45 squares 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

**D:** Cut 1 strip 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × WOF; subcut into 18 rectangles 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 2".

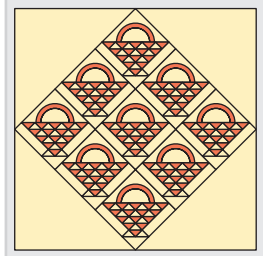
**E:** Cut 1 strip 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut into 5 squares 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

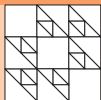
**Corner triangles:** Cut 1 strip 20" × WOF; subcut into 2 squares 20" × 20", cut in half diagonally once.

**B:** Cut 5 strips 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut into 77 squares 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>". Or cut each jelly roll strip into 9 squares 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

**Handles:** Cut 9 bias strips to length desired.

### CUTTING

*Note: Combine sets of A, C, D from one fat quarter with sets of B and E from another for each block. Refer to Sewing Half-Square Triangles (page 123) for B/C.*

#### From each of 16 fat quarters:

**A:** Cut 2 squares 5½" × 5½"

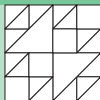

subcut into 175 squares 3 7/8" × 3 7/8".

**D:** Cut 12 strips 3 1/2" × WOF;  
subcut into 140 squares 3 1/2" × 3 1/2".

**B:** Cut 2 strips 3 7/8" × length of fat quarter;  
subcut into 9 squares 3 7/8" × 3 7/8".

**C:** Cut 1 strip 6 7/8" × length of fat quarter;  
subcut into 3 squares 6 7/8" × 6 7/8".

### CUTTING

#### Fabric 1:

**A:** Cut 6 strips 6<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut 35 squares 6<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 6<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

**C:** Cut 4 strips 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" × WOF; subcut 18 squares 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" × 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>".

**E:** Cut 4 strips 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut 35 squares 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

**G:** Cut 5 strips 2<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut 70 squares 2<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 2<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

#### Fabric 2:

**B:** Cut 6 strips 6<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut 35 squares 6<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 6<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

**D:** Cut 4 strips 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" × WOF; subcut 18 squares 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" × 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>".

**F:** Cut 4 strips 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut 35 squares 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

**H:** Cut 5 strips 2<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × WOF; subcut 70 squares 2<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" × 2<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>".

Refer to *Sewing Half-Square Triangles* (page 123) for B/C.

**A:** Cut 1 strip 3" × WOF; subcut 10 squares 3" × 3".

**C:** Cut 2 strips 3¾" × WOF; subcut 20 squares 3¾" × 3¾".

**E:** Cut 2 strips 5½" × WOF; subcut 10 rectangles 5½" × 8".

**F:** Cut 1 strips 5½" × WOF; subcut 5 squares 5½" × 5½".

**G:** Cut 1 strips 5½" × WOF; subcut 10 rectangles 5½" × 3".

**B:** Cut 2 strips 3¾" × WOF; subcut 20 squares 3¾" × 3¾".

**D:** Cut 3 strips 3" × WOF; subcut 30 squares 3" × 3".

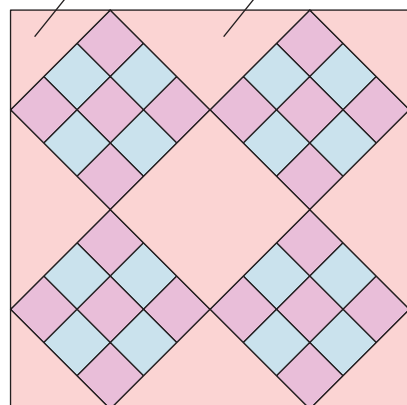
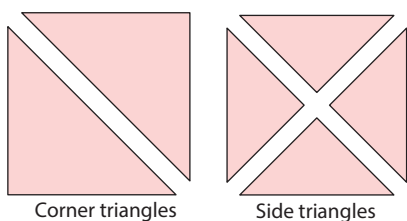
