## Just One Charm Pack Quilts - Nine Patch Challenge Quilt Errata - June 2021

Every pattern in this book has been tested twice and technical edited, but unfortunately mistakes still happen and for that we truly apologize. The pattern Nine-Patch Challenge in Just One Charm Pack Quilts book contains an error in the cutting of the background fabric.

The background (Gray) cutting instructions reads:

Cut 4 strips 6" × WOF.

Subcut the strips into 20 squares 6" × 6" (each strip can yield 6 squares).

The cutting instructions should read:

Cut 4 strips 6 ½" × WOF.

Subcut the strips into 20 squares  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (each strip can yield 6 squares).

If you have *already cut your background squares to 6" x 6"* there are two options to still use these squares so that no fabric is wasted.

## **OPTION 1** - Trim the nine-patch blocks


After sewing your pieced nine-patch blocks  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", trim them down to 6" x 6" by trimming a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " off of each of the four sides of the blocks. Use these trimmed blocks with the bg squares 6" x 6" to make the quilt top.

The quilt will finish about 3" smaller in width and height than the original design.

## **OPTION 2 - Make the background squares into plus blocks**

You will need  $\frac{3}{2}$  yard of an additional fabric (called the inner fabric) to make these blocks.

- 1. Inner fabric Cut 8 strips 1" x WOF.
  - a. Sub-cut 4 strips into 20 rectangles 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (each strip can yield 6 rectangles).
  - b. Sub-cut 4 strips into 40 rectangles 1 ½" x 3" (each strip can yield 13 rectangles).
- 2. Cut each bg square 6" x 6" in half vertically and horizontally to make a total of 80 bg squares 3" x 3" (each 6" square will yield (4) 3" squares).
- 3. Sew together the following squares and rectangles to make a plus block 6 ½" x 6 ½". Repeat to make a total of 20 plus blocks 6 ½" x 6 ½".
  - 4 bg squares 3" x 3"
  - 2 inner fabric rectangles 1 ½" x 3"
  - 1 inner fabric rectangle 1 ½" x 6 ½"
- 4. Use these plus blocks 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " for the bg squares 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " during the quilt top assembly.
