6 Place the front and back with right sides together. Starting at the sleeve opening, sew around the underarm curve to the bottom opening, as shown.



7 Finish the neckline, sleeve openings, and hems as desired (see Hemming, page 19, and Edge Finishes, page 21).

NOTE: Use these sewing techniques when sewing a cardigan, coatigan, or kimono. Instead of a front piece and back piece, there will be 2 front pieces. This creates a front opening that can be finished with any of the edge finishing techniques (see Edge Finishes, page 21).
