

Page 12, Flat Pyramid


The first illustration is incorrect. See the attached page for the corrected illustration.

Diamond

- **1.** Cut a strip the width noted in the pattern.
- **2.** At the right end of the strip, position the ruler with one side along one edge of the strip. Cut the end of the strip to a 60° angle.




- **3.** Rotate the strip so the cut end is to the left. Place the ruler so the tip is at one edge of the strip, the line of the size noted in the pattern is along the other edge, and the edge of the ruler is at the corner of the cut end.
- **4.** Rotary cut *only* along the side opposite the first cut. Check with the actual size template (page 59).




5. Keep moving the tool along the same side of the strip, lining up the cut edge and the side of the tool as shown. Always cut the side opposite the first cut. Strips may be stacked up to 6 thicknesses and all cut at once.

Flat Pyramid

- **1.** Cut the strip width as required in the pattern.
- **2.** At the right end of the strip, position the ruler with one side along one edge of the strip. Cut the end of the strip to a 60° angle.



3. Rotate the strip so the cut end is to the left. Align the ruler with the edge along the cut end and the size of the flat pyramid along the bottom edge of the strip.



- **4.** Cut along the right side. Check your piece with the actual size templates (pages 58, 59, 60, or 62).
- **5.** Turn the ruler and cut the next flat pyramid from the other side of the strip with the size of the flat pyramid along the top edge.
