## How to Sew 4-At-a-Time No-Waste Flying Geese

If you want to sew 4-at-a-time Flying Geese of different sizes, use these formulas:

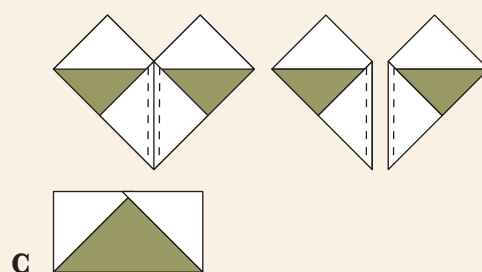
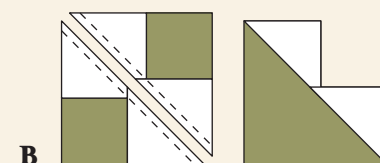
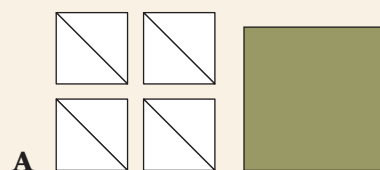
Large square size +  $1\frac{1}{2}"$  = finished width of Flying Geese

Small square size +  $1"$  = finished height of Flying Geese

1. Pair 4 small squares ( $5" \times 5"$ ) with a larger square ( $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ ). Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all of the smaller squares. **fig. A**

2. Place 2 small squares on opposite corners of the large square RST, with the drawn lines along the large square's diagonal. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}"$  away from both sides of the drawn lines. Cut on the drawn line, and press the seams open. **fig. B**

3. Layer the remaining 2 small squares on the corners of the Step 2 units, correctly orienting the drawn lines. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}"$  away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line, and press the seams open to complete 4 Flying Geese. **fig. C**



## Snowball Corner Units

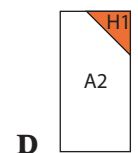
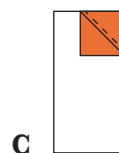
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all 16 H1 squares.

2. Place an H1 square on the top right corner of an A2 rectangle RST. Sew on the drawn line. **fig. C**

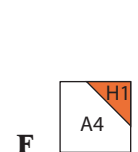
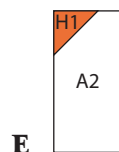
3. Trim off the corner  $\frac{1}{4}"$  away from the seam. Press the seam open. Call this Unit A2H1-Right. Repeat Step 2 to make 4 units. **fig. D**

4. Repeat Steps 2-3, placing the H1 square on the top left corner of an A2 rectangle RST, to make 4 units. **fig. E**

5. Repeat Steps 2-3, placing the H1 square on a corner of an A4 square RST, to make 8 units. **fig. F**

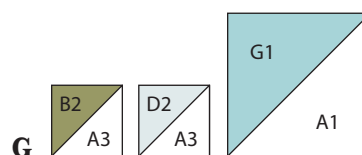

## Half-Square Triangle Units (HST)

1. Follow the instructions in How to Make 2-at-a-Time HSTS (page 36) to make 12 A3B2 HSTs, 4 A3D2 HSTs. Trim to  $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$ .

2. Follow the instructions in How to Make 2-at-a-Time HSTS (page 36) to make 4 A1G1 HSTs. Trim to  $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ . **fig. G**



5. Arrange the following units (from top to bottom) into a column: A4 strip, Unit C1, A4 strip, Unit C2, A4 strip, Unit C1, A4 strip. **fig. O**

6. Sew the units together, and press the seams toward the A4 strips. Call this Column C, measuring  $16\frac{1}{2}'' \times 48\frac{1}{2}''$ . **fig. P**

### Assemble the Quilt

1. Arrange the columns into the following order (from left to right), paying close attention to the orientation of the columns: Column A, Column B, A3 strip, Column C, A3 strip, Column B, Column A. **fig. Q**

2. Sew the columns together. Follow the arrows for pressing direction. Call this the Center Unit.
