Page 71, The first shape to cut from the cream fabrics should be quarter-square triangles. The illustration at the top of the right column and the number of 18"-long strips to cut has been corrected. See the attached page.







Rotary Cutting Layouts

Below are figures illustrating how to cut strips and patches for Savannah. The total number of strips of each type is listed to the right of wall, twin, or queen sizes. Cut the widest strips first. Cut narrower strips from










the leftovers. From some strips, you may be able to cut one more patch than I show because I have allowed for pre-shrinking the fabric. See page 73 for more rotary cutting details for F and I.

* Note that the cream strips for I are cut 2" wide for the paper-template method, but they are cut 1 7/8+ " wide for optional rotary cutting without a template. (In the paper-template method, you will have a sliver of waste between pairs of triangles.) 1 7/8+ " is halfway between 1 7/8" and 2".

Stellar Tip: Refer to page 10 for methods, meanings, for and information to be gleaned from diagrams. Also

read page 10 if you are wondering whether dimensions include seam allowances or what ">" means.
