PROJECT

*Andy reconnected with family while exploring
the history of his great-grandmother's antique quilt.
Make this 84" × 104" quilt to add to your family's heritage.*

MATERIALS

Light fabric: Scraps to total 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ yards

Dark fabric: Scraps to total 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards

Neutral fabric: 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards

Inner border: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard

Outer border: 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ yards

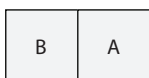
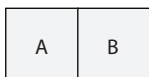
Backing (108"-wide): 3 yards

Batting: 92" × 112"

Binding (cut 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide): $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

ASSEMBLE AND FINISH QUILT

1. Assemble as shown.



Quilt assembly

2. Add inner borders.

Cut 2 strips $2'' \times 90\frac{1}{2}''$ for sides.

Cut 2 strips $2'' \times 73\frac{1}{2}''$ for top and bottom.

Sew borders to sides and then top and bottom.

3. Add outer borders.

Cut 2 strips $5\frac{3}{4}'' \times 93\frac{1}{2}''$ for sides.

Cut 2 strips $5\frac{3}{4}'' \times 84''$ for top and bottom.

Sew borders to sides and then top and bottom.

4. Layer the pieced top with batting and backing.

Quilt and bind as desired.
