# FRAYED EDGES

See full quilt on back cover.

Andy reconnected with family while exploring the history of his great-grandmother's antique quilt.

Make this 84" × 104" quilt to add to your family's heritage.

#### **MATERIALS**

Light fabric: Scraps to total 17/8 yards

Dark fabric: Scraps to total 31/8 yards

Neutral fabric: 31/8 yards

Inner border: 5% yard

Outer border: 15/8 yards

Backing (108"-wide): 3 yards

**Batting:** 92" × 112"

Binding (cut 21/4" wide): 3/4 yard

#### ASSEMBLE AND FINISH QUILT

**1.** Assemble as shown.



Quilt assembly

2. Add inner borders.

Cut 2 strips 2"×90½" for sides.

Cut 2 strips 2"×73½" for top and bottom.

Sew borders to sides and then top and bottom.

3. Add outer borders.

Cut 2 strips 5¾"×93½" for sides.

Cut 2 strips 5¾"×84" for top and bottom.

Sew borders to sides and then top and bottom.

**4.** Layer the pieced top with batting and backing. Quilt and bind as desired.
