March 30, Picnic Patch

Cut size of piece C should be 2" x 3 1/2"

April 2, Antique Tile

Cut piece C as a square only, do not cut in half.

June 17, Alaska Homestead

Square B at the bottom should be labeled A, and HST C should be labeled B.

August 12, Basket of Squares


Small triangle should be labeled D and cut size is HST 3 7/8".

August 20, Double Stars

Follow the piecing as shown with squares and triangles, not anvil shapes.

August 21, Double T

This block is the same as February 16, Double Geese. To make a variation, the corner squares can be HSTs. Cut HST D 6 7/8".



August 25, Young Man's Fancy

Square C at the bottom should be B and rectangle B should be C.

September 3, Rolling Star Block

Follow the piecing as shown with squares and HSTs, not anvil shapes.

October 5, Jack in the Box

Follow the piecing as shown with HSTs and flying geese, not parallelograms.

October 10, Niña

Follow the piecing as noted with HSTs and a rectangle for the boat, not a trapezoid.

October 11, Pinta


Follow the piecing as shown with HSTs and a rectangle for the boat, not a trapezoid.

October 12, Santa Maria

Follow the piecing as shown with HSTs and a rectangle for the boat, not a trapezoid.

December 5, Star of Hope

The correct line drawing is below. Rectangle E is cut 2 1/2 " x 4 1/2 "



December 6, Jerusalem Block

Cut piece B as a square only, do not cut in half.

December 9, The Rosebud

The center rectangle on each side should be F and is cut 1 1/2 " x 4 1/2 ".
